

## **Proposal to group Yeovilton Parish Council with Limington Parish Meeting to form a single parish council**

### **Local Governance and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007**

South Somerset District Council has commenced a Community Governance Review in response to a request from Yeovilton Parish Council and Limington Parish Meeting, requesting that the review should consider:

- the grouping of the two parishes to form a single parish council.
- If agreed, amend the name of the new Parish Council to **Yeovilton and District Parish Council**. This will encompass all the villages in the new parish.

During October and November 2021, we asked for your views on this proposal and 83% of the responses received were in favour of the proposal.

Having taken into account the consultation responses made during the first stage of consultation, and having regard to the need to ensure that Community Governance within the area reflects the identities and interests of the Community, and is effective and convenient, the draft recommendation of South Somerset District Council is:

**“To accept the vote from the people of Yeovilton Parish and Limington and to form a single parish council to be named “Yeovilton and District Parish Council”.**
