

**Minutes of a meeting of Yeovilton Parish Council held on Tuesday June 12<sup>th</sup> 2018 held at  
St. Bartholomew's Church, Yeovilton at 7.30pm.**

**16. Apologies**

Apologies were received from Mr. D. Board, Mr. M. Lewis, County Councillor & PCSO John Winfield.

**17. Minutes**

The Minutes of the previous meeting, having been circulated, were signed as correct.

**18. Declarations of Interest**

There were no Declarations of Interest.

**19. Open Session & County and District Councillors' reports**

In the absence of Mr. Lewis, County Councillor, there were no County Council issues reported.

Mr. Capozzoli, District Councillor, stated that he had nothing to report.

Rev. J. Webb highlighted the state of the verges in the area of the Podimore roundabout, which are impacting on road safety. It was agreed to contact Highways England.

Mr. A. Hickman highlighted a proposed Raft race being held on the river Yeo for Charity.

Mr. Moffatt stated that following his Email expressing concern at the short notice given from the Organisers AHA, of the Air day event, more time had been given for residents to provide the necessary information reference residents' passes. Mr. Graydon, CRO stated that he entirely agreed that the delay in sending out the letters giving such short notice had been unacceptable, and would not be happening again next year.

**20. RNAS matters, Police & Community issues & Church matters**

Mr. Graydon, CRO reported that he will be meeting with Mrs. Horsey Davis on Wednesday.

Mr/ Graydon informed the meeting the there had been sheep getting onto the Runway due at the state of the perimeter fencing. There has been to date no response from DIO on getting this fencing repaired. It was agreed that this is highly unsatisfactory on the part of the MOD.

Mr. Browncey highlighted blocked drains with grass from the works trimming the banks from Stockwich Cross towards Bridgehampton.

The Council noted the apologies received from PCSO J. Winfield & the Emails received from the Police via Farm Watch.

Rev. Faulkner gave an update on the Centenary WW1 events, informing the meeting that there is at the moment a Floral display in St. Mary Major Church, Ilchester depicting the story of WW1. This will remain in place until Sunday. There is also a Poppy display and members were given a copy of the Leaflet, which has been produced giving details of those who served in WW1 and where they lived in the Parish, this forming part of a Remembrance walk.

**21. Planning matters**

The Council noted that there was still no decision by SCC to date, reference SCC application 17/01166/CPO at RNAS for the construction of a 360 sq.m. Waste Transfer Station to replace existing Recycling & Waste Management Centre.

The Council discussed and supported application 18/01665.FUL for Mr. D. Blackwell at 2, Courtry Cottages, Bridgehampton for the erection of a two storey & demolition of single storey extension

The Council after discussion, agreed to note application 8/01137FUL at Blackberry Farm, Urgashay for the siting of a log cabin for temporary use for an agricultural worker (adjacent Parish)

The Council after discussion, agreed to note application 18/01593/S73 at the Solar Farm, Smithy Farm, to vary planning Condition 10 of Flood risk assessment 17/00225/S73A to allow for a revised drainage strategy to address standing water issues within the site

The Council noted that there have been no applications received from either Mr. Mark Stevens, Stockwich Farm, Stockwich to erect an agricultural storage building or from Mr. M. Edwards for Manor Farm, Yeovilton.

**22. Financial matters**

The Council noted that the balances at 29/05/18 Current a/c £359.34p & Business savings a/c £5,177.39p

The Council noted that the relevant annual returns have been sent to the External auditor, posted on the Website and the Notice of Electors' Rights on put on the Notice board.

**23. Highway matters**

Mrs. Jones reported that there is to be a meeting on Monday next, with Highways England agents to be updated with their detailed proposals for the dualling of the A.303 Podimore to Sparkford.

The Council noted that there had been a positive response from the owner of the Livery stables in Yeovilton, with regards to driving speeds of their clients.

Mrs. Jones reported and the Council were pleased to record that the Orders have been published for the extension of the 40 MPH on the B.3151 from Ilchester to RNAS Yeovilton, with there being a 30 MPH being put in place on the section through RNAS Yeovilton.

**24. Flooding issues**

There was nothing reported on the flooding issues, as reported at the last meeting.

**25. Tree matters**

Mr. Elliott stated that he had no matters to report.

**26. Rights of Way**

The Council were read an Email received from an Ilchester resident, expressing her concern at the overgrown state of the Right of Way at Hainbury Mill. Mr. Barlow stated that he will report this issue.

**27. Correspondence**

The Council noted the Somerset Waste Partnership newsletter (circulated).

**28. Items for report, or for the agenda of the next meeting**

Mr. Browncey reported that there is a lorry that has been parked at Bridgehampton, which technically should be left over night at the operator's premises. After discussion, it was agreed that Mr. Elliott would make contact with the person involved.

It was noted that there are to be some private parties being held in Yeovilton village following Air Day.

Mr. Barlow gave his apologies for the next meeting.
